## Bus Parking Locations

(As provided by the D.C. Dept of Transportation)

1. **Arlington National Cemetery Visitor Center**, 32 spaces, 7 days, April–September: 8 am – 7 pm
2. **Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception**, *400 Michigan Avenue NE, Washington DC*  
Lower Parking Lot, Michigan Avenue and Harewood Rd, NE (Shrine visitors only), 100 spaces, 7 days, 7am – 7 pm Free. Guided tours Mon-Sat 9am-11am and 1pm-3pm. Sundays, 1.30pm–4.00pm.  
**Metro:** Catholic University, Brooklyn Stop. For information, call (202) 526-8300.
3. **Botanical Garden**, *300 Jefferson Drive, SW*, south side, 1 space, 2 hour parking, 7am–6:30 pm Daily
4. **Bureau of Printing & Engraving / Holocaust Memorial Museum**, *1200-1300 block, D Street, SW*  
South side, 10 spaces, 7 days. 4-hr. limit. Free.
5. **Bureau of Printing & Engraving / Holocaust Memorial Museum**, *200 14th Street, SW*  
Eastside, 4 spaces, 15-minute tour bus stand, 9:30 am-9:30 pm Daily.
6. **City Center Parking (Former site of DC Convention Center)**, *900 9th Street, NW*  
Enter from and exit to southbound 9th Street, NW between New York Ave and H Street. (9th Street is one-way southbound.) 30 spaces, open 6 am–midnight (Sunday to Thursday), 6 am–2 am Friday and Saturday), 1–2 hours \$15, 3–4 hours \$25, 4–24 hours with in and out privileges \$35. 7. **Cruise Lines / SW Waterfront**, *600 Water Street, SW*  
South side, 2 spaces, No Parking except tour buses
8. **Fish Market / SW Waterfront**, *900 block, Maine Avenue, SW*  
North side, 5 spaces, 7 days, 7 am – 6:30 pm, 4 hr. limit. Free.
9. **Fish Market / SW Waterfront**, *700 block, Maine Avenue, SW*  
North side, 6 spaces, Monday-Friday, 9:30 am – 4 pm, 4 hr. limit. Free.
10. **Frederick Douglass Historic Home**, *1411 W Street, SE*  
Call 1-800-967-2283 for reservations or additional information.
11. **George Washington University**, *2400 block of K Street, NW*, south side (eastbound). 2 spaces.

12. **George Washington University, 2000 block Pennsylvania Avenue, NW**, north side, 2 spaces, 7 days, 7 am–4 pm, 2 hr. limit. Free. Signage missing.
13. **Jefferson, Lincoln, Roosevelt & WWII Memorials**, Hains Point bus parking lot, 11 spaces, 7 days. Free. Enter from southbound Ohio Drive, SW. Drive past the golf course entrance to the tip of Hains Point.
14. **National Arboretum**, 3500 block, New York Avenue, NE (Arboretum visits only)-28 spaces, Monday–Friday, 9 am–1:30 pm; Saturday 10 am–2 pm. Free.
15. **National Geographic Museum, 1700 block, DeSales Street, NW-south side**, 8 spaces, 7 days, Free.
16. **Robert F. Kennedy (RFK) Stadium, Lot 8. 500 spaces**  
Motorcoach parking is available at RFK Lot 8 on most days and at RFK Lot 6 on other days, with significantly different ingress and egress routes for each (depending on the game schedule). Consult the website at [DC Sports and Entertainment Commission \(Motorcoach Parking at RFK\)](#) to obtain explicit instructions. In general, access to both lots is via the SE/SW (Eisenhower) Expressway as far as Barney Circle, but different from that point on. Open daily from 8 am to 5 pm for \$30/day with in-and-out privileges. Credit cards accepted for prepaid vouchers, but only cash or vouchers are accepted on site. Operators' lounge is under construction next to parking - three blocks from Stadium Armory Metrorail Station. 17. **Union Station Parking Garage, 30 Massachusetts Avenue, NE**  
Enter from Massachusetts Ave at the front of Union Station and up the east ramp to the garage, 24 hours daily, 7 days: 7am–7pm, \$20 per entry, 7pm–7am, \$10 per entry. Reserved \$50 daily flat rate. No in-and-out privileges. Phone: (202) 898-1950.
18. **Washington Monument (north), 1700 block Virginia Avenue, NW**, south side, 5 spaces, 7 days, 7:00 am – 6:30 pm, 2 hr. limit. Free. These spaces may be suspended due to construction activity.
19. **Washington Monument (south), 1500 block, Independence Avenue, SW**, north side, 10 spaces, 7 days. Free. See illustration under “Washington Monument” in the section on “National Park Service Memorials” [above](#).
20. **Washington National Cathedral, 3101 Wisconsin Avenue, NW**  
Buses and groups may only visit the Cathedral with a reservation. No stopping or drop-offs permitted. Buses should follow parking instructions given when reservation is confirmed. Phone 202-537-6207 x5. **Website:** [www.groups.cathedral.org](http://www.groups.cathedral.org)
21. **White House, 200–400 block, 15th Street, NW**, west side, 9 spaces, 7 days, 7 am–6:30 pm, 2 hr limit. Free.
22. **National Zoological Park, 3000 block of Connecticut Avenue, NW**  
Unload passengers at Bus Lot. Park in lot E, 50 spaces. Free parking for zoo visitors only, otherwise \$15/day. Grounds open daily: April 6 to Oct. 25, 6 am–8 pm; October 26 to April 5, 6 am–6 pm Bus parking reservations are REQUIRED, from September to mid-June. For more information, call (202) 673-4989.
